None this month

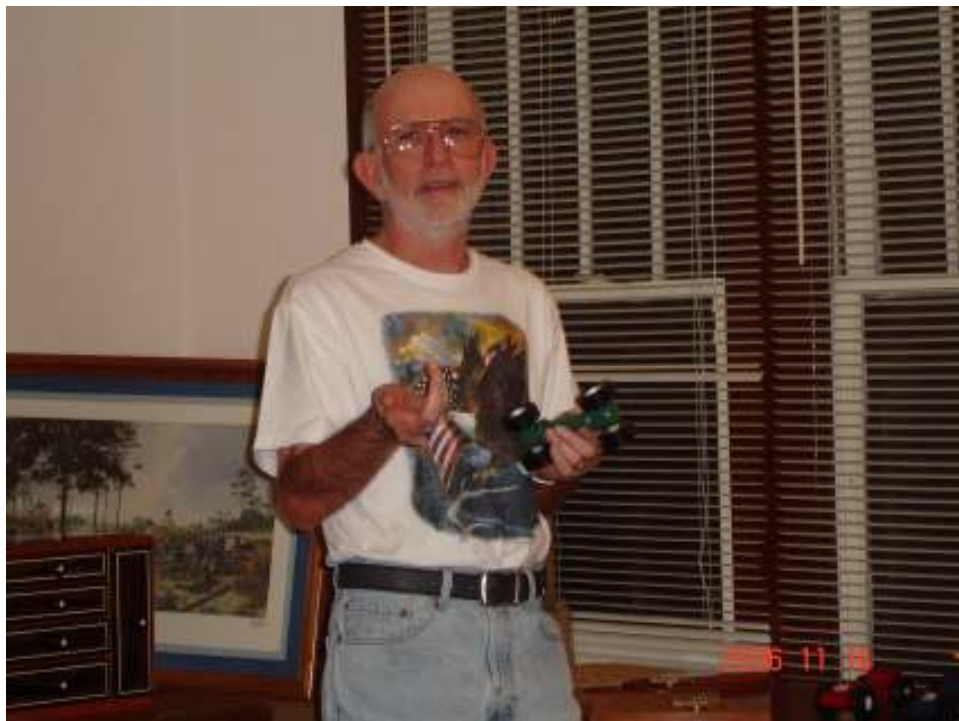
