## November Meeting

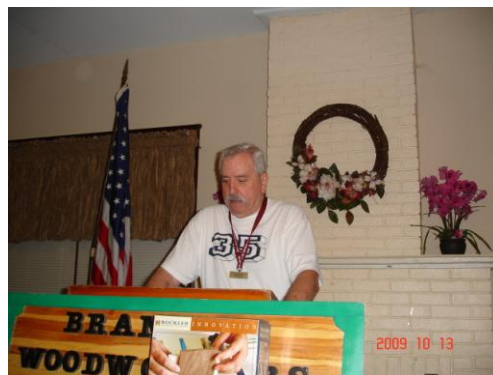
The November meeting is on Tuesday the 10<sup>th</sup>. We do not currently have a program scheduled.

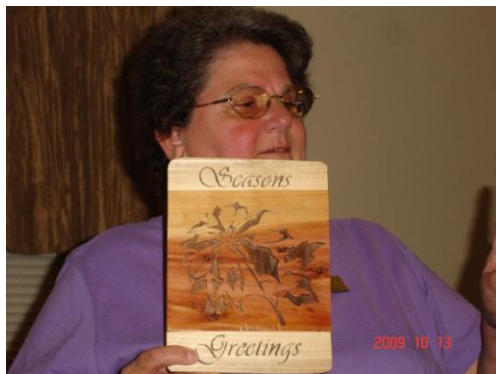
## Show and Tell

Lloyd made a bi-plane out of red oak and walnut. This is one of his Fair Entries this year.



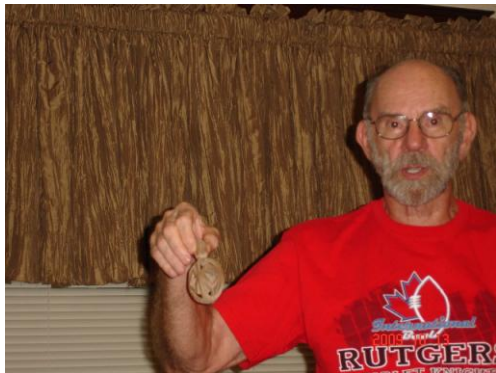
Lloyd made something else out of plywood, but I can't remember what and I couldn't read what he wrote on the Show and Tell slip! ☺
